

# SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INCOMING EXCHANGE STUDENTS (2017/18)



„We support your dream to study in Germany at DHBW Heilbronn“

**DHBW HEILBRONN** offers attractive scholarships for Incoming students, whether you join the Junior Program of Business Administration or study one semester in one of our undergraduate programs in German.

**SOME SCHOLARSHIPS** are awarded in advance (with admissions notification) and others during your semester at DHBW Heilbronn.

## **COLA (Cost of Living Allowance) Scholarships for Incoming Students** (awarded with acceptance)

In academic year 2017/18 DHBW is awarding 3 scholarships of €1,000.00 per stay.

The target group is Incoming exchange students with academic merit and financial need. Financial need can include coming from universities from countries within the ERASMUS bracket III (or ERASMUS associated countries with a similar cost of living) or recommendation from your Academic or Study Abroad adviser. Selection criteria include very good academic background plus personal engagement and leadership qualities. This scholarship can be combined with other scholarships like ERASMUS, and be used to help defray personal expenses (travel, rent, food, etc.).

**Application procedure** and documents to submit (in addition to application package)

### **Application Document**

Motivational statement expressing why you have the qualities meriting a scholarship (combined with the motivational statement in the application package)  
Letter of recommendation from a professor at your institution.

Submit the scholarship application with the normal Admissions application

**Deadline:** 31 May

The decision will be sent with the acceptance letter (mid-June)

## **DHBW Heilbronn also awards Donors' Scholarships (Stibet I & BWI-Stiftung) for Incoming Exchange Students** (awarded during the Semester)

DHBW-Heilbronn also awards Scholarships to selected students who demonstrate outstanding dedication and performance. These are awarded in the course of the semester. These scholarships cannot be combined with ERASMUS scholarships.

The Scholarships are awarded in amounts from ca. €400.00 to €1,200.00 per stay. The quantity of scholarships and award levels vary, based on funding sources (foundations, government, etc.).

Criteria include outstanding participation and leadership (in class, during excursions and co-curricular activities) combined with very good academic performance (based on midterm results).

Awards will be made toward the end of the semester.

### **Application Documents:**

Scholarship Application Form including Motivational Statement describing your accomplishments and contributions to the program.
