Documents to be evaluated include: Transcript of Records (Grades), CV, Letter of Recommendation from your home institution, and your Motivational Statement. A video interview may be arranged if necessary. While your academic preparation and grades are important, other factors will be considered as well. Selection criteria include very good academic background plus personal engagement and leadership qualities.

Motivational Statement

In your own words, give us some insights about who you are! What are your extracurricular activities, special academic interests or passions, and how can a semester at DHBW help fulfill them? (Don't write what you think we want to hear – write something to give us an insight into yourself, your qualifications and goals.)

Deadline

Send your scholarship application together with your regular application documents. The application deadline is May 31st for Fall 2017.
